## **Record amendment application**

- 1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by Application 24021-A001 registered on October 31, 2018, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, to delete line 7 of Licence 2298. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operated in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 2298.
- 2. ATCO stated that its records show that line 7 has been previously operated as part of the low-pressure distribution service and therefore should be removed from Licence 2298 since only high-pressure gas utility pipelines are licenced.
- 3. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.
- 4. Based upon the information provided, the Commission is satisfied that the proposal is of a minor nature, no person will be directly and adversely affected by the proposal and no significant adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.
- 5. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
