**Pipeline Record Amendments in the Holden Area
Licence 9416
Proceeding 24218
Application 24218-A001**

Record amendment application

1. ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (ATCO), by Application 24218-A001 registered on January 9, 2019, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following:

- “wall thickness” amendment of lines 1, 3, 7, 9, 11 and 13 from 0.00 millimetres to 6.35 millimetres
- “pipe type” amendment of lines 1, 3 and 7 from UUUUUU to 5L

2. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 9416.

3. ATCO stated that lines 1, 3, 7, 9, 11 and 13 of Licence 9416 were originally licenced in 1977 with a “wall thickness” of 6.35 millimetres. Licence amendments were made in numerous locations on Licence 9416 in which the lines had their wall thickness changed incorrectly. To correct the error, Licence 9416 would be amended to indicate the wall thickness of lines 1, 3, 7, 9, 11 and 13 in accordance with the original licence. In addition, the “type” of lines 1, 3 and 7 would be amended in accordance with the original licence. The changes are required to ensure the wall thickness and type are correctly reflected on the record.

4. ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

5. Based upon the information provided, the Commission is satisfied that the proposal is of a minor nature, no person will be directly and adversely affected by the proposal, and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

6. The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
