ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1609804 registered on July 30, 2013, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Township 52, Range 23 west of the Fourth Meridian:

- re-instating lines 4 and 11 as lines 14 and 15
- mapping amendment of Line 5
- status amendment of Line 12 from operating to not constructed

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 6317.

ATCO stated that in 2009, it applied for approval to lower 140 metres of 273.1-millimetre (mm) pipeline to accommodate a highway upgrade project. However, upon further review of the project it was determined that the original alignment was adequate to accommodate the proposed highway project. The pipeline lowering project was then cancelled. After reviewing the project information, ATCO is applying to adjust the licence to accurately reflect the pipeline in service.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
