ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610237, registered on January 13, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Township 51, Range 26 west of the Fourth Meridian:

- status amendment of Line 1 from operating to removed
- mapping amendment of Line 1
- amendment of “To” LSD location of Line 1 from 6 to 5

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence 8227.

ATCO stated that upon review of its records it was determined that a mapping correction to Line 1 is required and that the line had been removed when the pressure regulating station was removed and the low pressure lines were tied in. This work was completed in 1990 but the licence was not changed to correct the operating status of the pipeline at the time. This application is to correct this oversight so that the most accurate information is reflected on the pipeline licence.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
