ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610289 registered on January 30, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Townships 52 and 53, Range 24 west of the Fourth Meridian:

- splitting Line 19 into lines 19, 272 and 273
- status amendment of Line 272 from operating to removed
- length amendment of original Line 19, now lines 19, 272 and 273, from 2.78 kilometres to 3.43 kilometres
- mapping amendment of Line 138

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Permit and Licence No. 2594.

ATCO stated that Line 138 was incorrectly mapped and that when the original application was submitted in 1986, Line 19 was not correctly split. This application is to correctly split Line 19 into lines 19, 272 and 273 and to amend the status of Line 272 from operating to removed. A mapping amendment to line 138 and a length amendment to original Line 19 is also required.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
