ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610403, registered on March 20, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to add an existing compressor station, previously approved by the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (AEUB) in 1998, to Permit and Licence No. 106 as a pipeline installation in Township 27, Range 25, west of the Fourth Meridian. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted under AEUB Approval No. 1998-2186.

ATCO stated that a compressor station was installed in 1998 by ATCO Pipelines (formerly Canadian Western Natural Gas Company Limited), subsequent to AEUB Approval 1998-2186. A recent review of licence records indicated that no installation number exists for this compressor station. This application is to correct this omission and re-licence this compressor station as Installation Number 1 under Permit and Licence No. 106.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended permit and licence is attached.
