ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610737 registered on July 17, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Township 51, Range 25, west of the Fourth Meridian:

- maximum operating pressure amendment from 5520 kilopascals to 340 kilopascals
- deletion of Line 1

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence No. 5318.

ATCO stated that upon review of its records it was determined that in 1985, Line 1 was converted to a low pressure gas distribution line and the licence was not amended at that time to reflect the correct information. Therefore, ATCO proposes to correct this oversight.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
