Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610763 registered on July 31, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the deletion of Line 48 in Township 10, Range 16, west of the Fourth Meridian. The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence No. 2027.

ATCO stated that Line 48 was originally constructed in 1961, with a maximum operating pressure (MOP) of 2,720 kilopascals (kPa), for the purpose of serving the Taber Potato Factory. In 1990, the installation of a pressure regulator reduced the MOP of Line 48 to 410 kPa. However, the licence was not updated at the time to account for the conversion of Line 48 to an intermediate pressure pipeline. ATCO requested the AUC to delete Line 48 from the licence as Line 48 is currently an intermediate pressure pipeline with a MOP less than 700 kpa and is not required to be licenced.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
