ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610816 registered on September 3, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Townships 52 and 53, Ranges 23 and 24, west of the Fourth Meridian:

- length amendment of Line 121 from five kilometres (km) to the revised length of 3.41 km
- length amendment of Line 125 from 0.49 km to the revised length of 0.54 km
- amendment of the 'To Location' Section of lines 121 and 125
- amendment of the 'From Location' LSD and Section of Line 125
- mapping amendment of lines 121 and 125
- wall thickness amendment of Line 89 from zero millimetres (mm) to 6.35 mm
- outside diameter amendment of Line 89 from 323.8 mm to 323.9 mm


The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence No. 2594.

ATCO stated that licensing errors were discovered when reviewing lines 89, 121 and 125 on Licence No. 2594 as part of the Urban Pipeline Replacement project.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
