## **Record amendment application**

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610916 registered on October 15, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for an environmental code correction for Line 188 in Township 38, Range 27, west of the Fourth Meridian. The proposed amendment is related to a new 219.1 millimetre pipeline that is being constructed from LSD 4-25-38-27-W4M to 1-1-38-27-W4M in accordance with approvals granted in Decision 2014-050.<sup>1</sup>

Upon review of the licence for Line 188 and the prepared environmental report, ATCO discovered that the watercourse crossing had not been identified on the licence.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
