ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610952 registered on October 24, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* for the following in Townships 25 and 26, Range 2, west of the Fifth Meridian:

- splitting Line 1 into lines 1 and 2
- amendment of the ‘To Location’ facility code of Line 1 from meter station (MS) to meter/regulating station (MR)
- addition of the Line 2 facility code “From Location” as MR and the “To Location” as MS

The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and operating in accordance with approvals granted in Licence No. 4219.

ATCO stated that the original Line 1 of Licence No. 4219 is currently reflected as a single line segment and does not reflect the existence of an intermediate MR station. Therefore, ATCO has applied to amend the pipeline licence to accurately reflect the record of this pipeline. ATCO stated that it will amend the maximum operating pressure of Line 2 to a reduced level in a subsequent application.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
