Record amendment application

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. (South) (ATCO), by Application No. 1610998 registered on November 18, 2014, filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* to amend the status of Line 7 in Township 46, Range 7, west of the Fourth Meridian from "operating" to "abandoned". The proposed amendment is related to facilities previously constructed and subsequently abandoned in accordance with approvals granted in Licence No. 9924.

ATCO stated that after reviewing its records it was determined that Line 7 of Licence No. 9924 was abandoned in 2002 and therefore has missed the 90 day notification window allowed by the AUC. The purpose of this application is to correct the licence due to that oversight by ATCO.

ATCO provided information respecting the need, nature and extent of the pipeline record amendment. Since the record amendment does not involve a ground disturbance, there will be no environmental impact.

Based upon the information provided, ATCO has demonstrated that the proposal is of a minor nature, no other person will be directly affected by the proposal and no adverse environmental impact will be caused by the proposed record amendment.

The Commission approves the application. The amended licence is attached.
