ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. The British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) approved the FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) Rate Schedule 30, Off-System Sales and Purchases Rate Schedule and Agreement (Canada and U.S.A.), through Order G-89-03, dated December 18, 2003. Since that date, the Commission has reviewed amendments as filed by FEI with the most recent amendment approved through Order G-197-11, dated November 24, 2011;
- B. Rate Schedule 30 contains the GasEDI base contract and FEI's set of Standard Provisions, both of which are used by FEI as the starting point for negotiation with counterparties with whom FEI wishes to execute off-system sales or purchase agreements;
- C. FEI amends its set of Standard Provisions over time in response to changing industry standards and practices as well as to carry out minor housekeeping changes which include formatting, updating information and clarifying statements;
- D. On February 1, 2016, FEI filed revised Rate Schedule 30 Tariff Pages which contained changes which were housekeeping in nature and responds to changing industry practices. FEI requested Commission endorsement of the revised Rate Schedule 30 Tariff Pages with an effective date of February 1, 2016; and
- E. The Commission has reviewed the filing and determines that the amendments should be approved.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to sections 60-61 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the British Columbia Utilities Commission approves for FortisBC Energy Inc. the revised Rate Schedule 30 Tariff pages, as filed on February 1, 2016, with an effective date of February 1, 2016.
