ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On March 11, 2016, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval a proposed Propane Supply Agreement between FEI and Superior Gas Liquids for the Revelstoke Service Area for the period from April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2018 (Agreement);
- B. On June 25, 2015, via Letter L-27-15, the Commission accepted the FEI Revelstoke 2015-2016 Annual Contracting Plan;
- C. FEI requests that the filing, Agreement, and associated documents remain confidential due to their commercially sensitive nature; and
- D. The Commission reviewed the FEI filing and is satisfied that the Agreement between FEI and Superior Gas Liquids is consistent with the 2015-2016 Annual Contracting Plan and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act* and the British Columbia Utilities Commission's Rules for Natural Gas Energy Supply Contracts:

1. The Commission approves the proposed Propane Supply Agreement between FortisBC Energy Inc. and Superior Gas Liquids as filed with the Commission on March 11, 2016.

2. FortisBC Energy Inc. is to file the executed copy of the Propane Supply Agreement with the Commission within 30 days of this order.
3. The Commission will keep the filing, Agreement, and documents associated with the filing confidential as requested due to its commercially sensitive nature.
