ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On February 13, 2012, Corix Multi-Utility Services Inc. (Corix) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) an Annual Contracting Plan (ACP) for propane supply to Panorama Mountain Village for the period of April 1, 2012 to March 31, 2013 Confidential Filing (the Filing);
- B. In the Filing, Corix sets out its tender process, Request for Quotation documents and price risk management strategy for securing competitive propane delivery service for Panorama Mountain Village;
- C. Corix requested that the details of the Filing be kept confidential due to their commercially sensitive nature as noted in the cover letter of the Filing;
- D. The Commission has reviewed the submission by Corix, and has determined that the filed Panorama propane ACP is appropriate and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the Commission approves the proposed Panorama propane ACP for Corix's intended propane purchases. The Commission will keep confidential the Filing as well as any responses by suppliers and related information filed by Corix.
