#### ORDER

#### WHEREAS:

- A. On February 26, 2010, Corix Multi-Utility Services Inc. (Corix) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) an Application to Change the Gas Cost Recovery Charge for Propane Service at Panorama Mountain Resort, effective April 1, 2010; and
- B. On March 18, 2010, the Commission issued Order G-52-10 in which, amongst other things, Corix was directed to file an Annual Contracting Plan (ACP) for its intended Panorama Mountain Resort propane purchases; and
- C. On March 24, 2010, Corix filed a Panorama Propane ACP Confidential Filing (the Filing); and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the submissions by Corix, and has determined that the proposed Panorama Propane ACP is appropriate and in the public interest.

### **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the proposed Panorama Propane ACP for Corix's intended propane purchases.
