SCHEDULE "A"

- 1) PCS is not permitted to sell to low-volume customers as defined by the *Gas Distribution Act*, 1999.
- 2) Sales by PCS will be executed under a North American Energy Standards Board (NAESB) or Gas EDI agreement or in accordance with the terms of a standard NAESB contract.
- 3) Should PCS wish to sell natural gas to any customer outside of those qualified above it must re-apply to the Board.
- 4) PCS will file, in confidence, reports of natural gas sales delivered though the Enbridge Gas New Brunswick distribution system. The reports will list the volume, the community and the average price of the natural gas for that month. The reports will be filed monthly on the 15th day of the month following the reporting month.
- 5) PCS must notify the Board within 30 days of any material changes to its corporate structure or ownership.
- 6) PCS must provide the Board, within 90 days of its year end, a divisional statement of the amount of gas sold and the gross revenue of those sales.
