## SCHEDULE "A"

1. Access Gas Services Inc. is permitted to operate as a gas marketer throughout the Province of New Brunswick with regards to the sale of natural gas.
2. Access Gas Services Inc. will file in confidence reports of natural gas sales delivered through the Enbridge Gas New Brunswick System. The reports will identify the amount of gas sold by class and by community, and will include the average price per class. The reports will be filed monthly on the 15<sup>th</sup> day following the end of the reporting month.
3. Access Gas Services Inc. will include in its monthly report the total amount of gas sold within the province including gas not delivered through the Enbridge Gas New Brunswick System.
4. Access Gas Services Inc. must comply with all requirements of the Board's decision on rules and regulations regarding the conduct of gas distributors and marketers.
5. Access Gas Services Inc. must adhere to the code of conduct for gas marketers.
6. Access Gas Services Inc. must notify the Board, within thirty days, of any material changes to its corporate structure or ownership.
7. Access Gas Services Inc. must ensure that all personnel providing service on its behalf for the installation and maintenance of natural gas and natural gas equipment and appliances, are properly qualified and licensed.
8. Access Gas Services Inc., prior to executing any agreement with a certified natural gas marketer to act as its agent, must ensure that the gas marketer has a Gas Marketer's Certificate issued by the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board.
9. Access Gas Services Inc. must notify the Board, within five business days, the name of any certified gas marketer with whom it has executed an agency agreement to act as an agent for Access Gas Services Inc.
10. Access Gas Services Inc. must provide an irrevocable letter of credit in favour of the Board in the amount of \$100,000. The letter of credit must remain in effect for one year, after which Access Gas Services Inc. may request that the requirement for financial security be eliminated.
