Alliance Pipeline Ltd. (Alliance) - Amended Tolls Effective 1 May 2013

The National Energy Board (the Board) received Alliance's 27 March 2013 filing for 2013 amended tolls to be made effective 1 May 2013. Alliance recalculated its 2013 tolls to exclude \$5 million of Demand Charge Credits related to Alliance's 2012 Highway 43-32 relocation project as required by the Board's decision dated 28 February 2013. Alliance also applied an adjustment to address the four month over-collection from interim tolls.

The Board received no objections to Alliance's proposed amended tolls from shippers or interested parties. In the Board's view, the proposed amended 2013 tolls filed by Alliance on 27 March 2013 are just and reasonable. The attached Order TO-003-2013 gives effect to this decision.

ORDER TO-003-2013

IN THE MATTER OF the *National Energy Board Act* (the Act) and the regulations made thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF a filing by Alliance Pipeline Ltd. (Alliance) dated 27 March 2013 for new tolls effective 1 May 2013 pursuant to Part IV of the Act filed with the National Energy Board (Board) under File OF-Tolls-Group1-A159-2012-01 01.

BEFORE the Board on 24 April 2013.

WHEREAS Alliance charged interim tolls as of 1 January 2013 pursuant to Order TOI-001-2012;

AND WHEREAS on 28 February 2013 the Board issued a decision disallowing the recapture of certain Demand Charge Credits in Alliance's 2013 tolls and ordered Alliance to recalculate and submit amended 2013 tolls;

AND WHEREAS on 27 March 2013, Alliance filed for amended tolls to be effective 1 May 2013;

AND WHEREAS Alliance sent a copy of its filing to all shippers and interested parties;

AND WHEREAS the Board has examined the Alliance filing for compliance with the Board's decision dated 28 February 2013;

AND WHEREAS the Board has received no objection from shippers;

IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Part IV of the Act, that:

- 1. Order TOI-001-2012, which authorized tolls that Alliance may charge on an interim basis effective 1 January 2013, is revoked effective 1 May 2013;
- 2. Alliance's applied-for 2013 tolls, as contained in its application dated 27 March 2013 are approved as final, effective 1 May 2013.
