E.B.L.O. 240 DECISION DATED MAY 27, 1993 [[12LH3-0:1](#)]

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On September 30, 1991, Union Gas Limited applied to the Ontario Energy Board for an order granting leave to construct 18.1 kilometres of 1219 millimetre pipeline, the Bright to Owen Sound Line, from its Bright Compressor Station to its Owen Sound Line Valve Site, both on its Dawn-Trafalgar line, in order to meet increased ex-franchise and in-franchise demand. The Bright to Owen Sound Line would be located in the Township of Blandford-Blenheim, in the County of Oxford and in the Township of North Dumfries, in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo.

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The Board denied the application on the grounds that there is uncertainty and confusion surrounding the need for the pipeline.

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In light of Union's integrated transmission, compression, distribution and storage system the Board encouraged Union to combine its application for the 1994 Trafalgar Expansion (E.B.L.O. 246) with any re-application for the Bright to Owen Sound Line, if Union is of the view that it has sufficient evidence to support any such re-application.
