IN THE MATTER OF the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. for an order that cancels or supersedes the existing Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity for certain geographic areas associated with the former Township of Charlottenburgh and the former Township of Lancaster within the Municipality of South Glengarry and establishes a single Certificate for the Township of South Glengarry.

DECISION AND ORDER

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (“Enbridge” or the “Applicant”) has filed an application dated December 18, 2007 with the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) pursuant to section 8 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended (the “Act”), for an order of the Board that cancels or supersedes the existing Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity (“Certificate”) associated with the former Township of Charlottenburgh and the former Township of Lancaster within the Municipality of South Glengarry and establishes a single Certificate for the Township of South Glengarry (the “Municipality”).

On January 1, 1998 the Township of Charlottenburgh, the Township of Lancaster and the Village of Lancaster amalgamated to form the Township of South Glengarry. Enbridge has a Certificate for the former Township of Charlottenburgh (FBC 195) and another Certificate for the former Township of Lancaster (FBC 198), but not for the Village of Lancaster.

The Board has assigned File No. EB-2007-0957 to this application.

The Board's Notice of Application and Written Hearing was published on February 7, 2008. There were no intervenors.

The Board finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and that public convenience and necessity requires that approval be given.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity F.B.C. 195 for the former Township of Charlottenburgh is cancelled.
2. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity F.B.C. 198 for the former Township of Lancaster is cancelled.
3. A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, attached as Appendix A to this Decision and Order, is granted to Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. to construct works to supply gas in the Township of South Glengarry.
