AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Union Gas Limited for an order superseding those parts of an existing Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for certain geographic areas that now form part of the Township of Mapleton and replacing these with a single Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the Township of Mapleton.

DECISION AND ORDER

Union Gas Limited ("Union") filed an application dated March 25, 2008 with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") under section 8 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended (the "Act"), for an order of the Board that supersedes those parts of an existing Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") for certain geographic areas for the former municipalities that now form part of The Township of Mapleton (the "Municipality") and replaces those aspects of the existing Certificate with a new Certificate for the amalgamated Corporation of the Township of Mapleton. The Board has assigned file number EB-2008-0067 to this application.

The Board's Notice of Application and Written Hearing was published on April 11, 2008. There were no intervenors.

On January 1, 1998, the former Village of Drayton and the former Township of Peel were amalgamated to form the Township of Mapleton. On January 1, 1999, the former Township of Mapleton and the former Township of Maryborough were amalgamated to form the Township of Mapleton.

A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (E.B.C. 29) was issued by the Board on April 17, 1963 granting Union the right to construct works to supply natural gas to 25 municipalities. The former Village of Drayton, the former Township of Peel and the former Township of Maryborough were three of these municipalities.

The Board finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and that public convenience and necessity requires that approval be given.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Those areas included in the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity E.B.C. 29 that relate to the former Village of Drayton, former Township of Peel and former Township of Maryborough are cancelled.
2. A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, attached as Appendix A to this Decision and Order, is granted to Union Gas Limited to construct works to supply gas in the Township of Mapleton.
