**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board) has received an application for certification pursuant to section 24 of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I—Industrial Relations)* (the *Code*) from the applicant seeking certification as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of Airport Terminal Services Canadian Company;

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has found the applicant to be a trade union within the meaning of the *Code*, has determined the unit described hereunder to be appropriate for collective bargaining and is satisfied that a majority of the employees of the employer in the unit wish to have the applicant trade union represent them as their bargaining agent.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that Unifor be, and it is hereby certified to be, the bargaining agent for a unit comprising:

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all employees of Airport Terminal Services Canadian Company employed at the Greater Moncton Roméo LeBlanc International Airport in the province of New Brunswick, **excluding** the administrative position of Ops Agent, the supervisor and persons above the rank of supervisor.
