**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board) has received an application for certification pursuant to section 24(1) of the *Canada Labour Code* (*Part I-Industrial Relations*) (the *Code*) from the applicant seeking certification as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of Avjet Holding Inc.;

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has found the applicant to be a trade union within the meaning of the *Code*, has determined the unit described hereunder to be appropriate for collective bargaining and is satisfied that a majority of the employees of the employer in the unit wish to have the applicant trade union represent them as their bargaining agent.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that the United Steelworkers, Local 7065 be, and it is hereby certified to be, the bargaining agent for a unit comprising:

all employees working in airport ground services at the Sept-Îles Airport at 1000 Laure Boulevard East, Sept-Îles, Quebec, G4R 4K2; at 17, 20 and 21 Aviation Générale East, Sept-Îles, Quebec, G4R 4K2; and at 34 Aviation Générale West, Sept-Îles, Quebec, G4R 4K2, **excluding** fuelling supervisors, operations manager, office employees and those automatically excluded by the law.
