WHEREAS the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board) has received an application from the applicant, pursuant to section 38(1) of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I—Industrial Relations)* (the *Code*), seeking revocation of certification order no. 11117-U issued on March 6, 2017, certifying the Canada Council of Teamsters as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of Swissport Canada Handling Inc. comprising:

all groomers, ramp/ground handlers, mechanics, communications co-ordinators and storekeepers working for Swissport Canada Handling inc. at the international airports in Montréal (Dorval and Mirabel), **excluding** office staff, managers, supervisors and those above the rank of supervisor;

AND WHEREAS, following investigation of the application, consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned and the taking of a representation vote, the Board is satisfied that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit no longer wish to be represented by the Canada Council of Teamsters;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that, pursuant to the provisions of section 39 of the *Code*, certification order no. 11117-U dated March 6, 2017 be revoked, and it is hereby revoked.
