**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board) has received an application from the applicant, pursuant to section 38(1) of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I–Industrial Relations)* (the *Code*), seeking revocation of certification order no. 10927-U issued on October 30, 2015, certifying the Public Service Alliance of Canada as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of Swissport Canada Fuel Services Inc. comprising:

all supervisors and administration employees of Swissport Canada Fuel Services Inc., working at the Vancouver International Airport, **excluding** the Payroll and Benefits Administrator, Facilities/Environmental Manager, Safety/Training Manager, Maintenance Manager, Operations Manager and Manager of Fuel Services.

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application, consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned and the taking of a representation vote, the Board is satisfied that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit no longer wish to be represented by the Public Service Alliance of Canada;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that, pursuant to the provisions of section 39 of the *Code*, certification order no. 10927-U dated October 30, 2015 be revoked, and it is hereby revoked.
