WHEREAS the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board), by order no. 10970-U dated March 10, 2016, certified the Public Service Alliance of Canada as the bargaining agent for a unit of employees of the Victoria Airport Authority comprised of:

all employees of the Victoria Airport Authority, **excluding** President and CEO; Executive Assistant; Director, Security and Terminal Operations; Chief Financial Officer; Manager, Finance and Accounting; Manager, Human Resources; Payroll and Human Resources Administrator; Director, Facilities; Vice-President, Operations & Development; Director, Operations and Safety; Manager, Safety and Emergency Services; and students;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board has received an application from the applicant, pursuant to section 18 of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I–Industrial Relations)* (the *Code*), seeking to amend the said order by removing the position of Vice-President, Operations & Development from the bargaining unit description and adding the position of Director, Business Development & Community Relations to the list of exclusions;

**AND WHEREAS** the certified bargaining agent is not opposed to this application;

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has determined that it is appropriate to grant the application;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board hereby declares that the Public Service Alliance of Canada is the bargaining agent for a bargaining unit comprising:

all employees of the Victoria Airport Authority, **excluding** President and CEO; Executive Assistant; Director, Security and Terminal Operations; Chief Financial Officer; Manager, Finance and Accounting; Manager, Human Resources; Payroll and Human Resources Administrator; Director, Facilities; Director, Business Development & Community Relations; Director, Operations and Safety; Manager, Safety and Emergency Services; and students.
