WHEREAS the Canada Labour Relations Board, by order no. 1355-U dated March 25, 1964, certified the International Association of Machinists as the bargaining agent for a unit of employees of Consolidated Aviation Fueling of Toronto Limited;

AND WHEREAS the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board) has received a joint application from the applicants, pursuant to section 18 of the *Canada Labour Code* (*Part I–Industrial Relations*) (the *Code*), seeking to amend the said order by updating the bargaining unit certificate to reflect the changes that have occurred since order no. 1355-U was issued;

AND WHEREAS, in September 1964, the certified bargaining agent changed its name to the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers;

AND WHEREAS, on March 27, 2002, Consolidated Aviation Fueling of Toronto Limited changed its name to Consolidated Aviation Fueling of Toronto, ULC;

AND WHEREAS, on April 13, 2017, Consolidated Aviation Fueling of Toronto, ULC changed its name to Allied Aviation Fueling of Toronto, ULC;

AND WHEREAS the parties are bound by a collective agreement which expired on December 10, 2016 but which continues to apply pursuant to Article 23 of that Agreement;

AND WHEREAS, given the passage of time, the classifications referred to in Board order no. 1355-U, issued in 1964, have become obsolete;

AND WHEREAS, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has determined that it is appropriate to grant the application;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board hereby declares that the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers is the bargaining agent for a bargaining unit comprising:

all fueling and fueling maintenance personnel of Allied Aviation Fueling of Toronto, ULC working at the Lester B. Pearson International Airport in Mississauga, Ontario, **excluding** supervisors and those above the rank of supervisor.
