**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board), by order no. 11113-U dated February 23, 2017, certified the Public Service Alliance of Canada as the bargaining agent for a unit of employees of the Charlottetown Airport Authority Inc. comprising:

all employees of the Charlottetown Airport Authority Inc., working at the Charlottetown Airport in Queens County, Province of Prince Edward Island, **excluding** the Chief Executive Officer, the Director, Engineering and Facilities, the Vice-President, Operations, the Director, Finance and Administration, and the Manager, Marketing and Communications.

**AND WHEREAS** the Board has received an application from the applicant, pursuant to section 18 of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I—Industrial Relations) (the Code)*, seeking to amend the said order by excluding the newly created position of Manager, Regulatory Affairs from the bargaining unit description;

**AND WHEREAS** the certified bargaining agent is not opposed to this application;

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has determined that it is appropriate to grant the application.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board hereby confirms that the Public Service Alliance of Canada is the bargaining agent for a bargaining unit comprising:

all employees of the Charlottetown Airport Authority Inc., working at the Charlottetown Airport in Queens County, Province of Prince Edward Island, **excluding** the Chief Executive Officer, the Director, Engineering and Facilities, the Vice-President, Operations, the Director, Finance and Administration, the Manager, Marketing and Communications, and the Manager, Regulatory Affairs.
