**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board), by order no. 10806-U dated May 7, 2015, certified the Public Service Alliance of Canada as the bargaining agent for a unit of employees of the Saskatoon Airport Authority comprising:

all employees of the Saskatoon Airport Authority, **excluding** the president and chief executive officer, vice-president corporate administration and CFO, vice-president operational excellence, vice-president, business development & service quality, manager facilities, manager airport development, manager, public safety and risk, manager customer and terminal services, human resources administrator, executive assistant and students.

**AND WHEREAS** the Board has received an application from the applicant, pursuant to section 18 of the *Canada Labour Code (Part I–Industrial Relations)* (the *Code*), seeking to amend the said order by adding the position of manager information technology to the list of exclusions contained in the bargaining unit description;

**AND WHEREAS** the certified bargaining agent is not opposed to this application;

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board has determined that it is appropriate to grant the application.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board hereby declares that the Public Service Alliance of Canada is the bargaining agent for a bargaining unit comprising:

all employees of the Saskatoon Airport Authority, **excluding** the president and chief executive officer, vice-president corporate administration and CFO, vice-president operational excellence, vice-president, business development and service quality, manager facilities, manager airport development, manager, public safety and risk, manager customer and terminal services, manager information technology, human resources administrator, executive assistant and students.
