AND WHEREAS, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board is satisfied that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit no longer wish to be represented by the Canadian Marine Mates and Engineers Union;

AND WHEREAS the bargaining agent has not opposed this application.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that, pursuant to the provisions of section 39 of the *Code*, the Canadian Marine Mates and Engineers Union is no longer entitled to represent the above-described voluntarily recognized bargaining unit of employees of NACC Shipping Canada Limited.
