**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board is satisfied that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit no longer wish to be represented by Unifor;

**AND WHEREAS**, the certified bargaining agent is not opposed to this application.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that, pursuant to the provisions of section 39 of the *Code*, certification order no. 10929-U dated November 26, 2015, be revoked, and it is hereby revoked.
