**WHEREAS** the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board) has received an application from the applicant, pursuant to section 38(1) of the *Canada Labour Code* (the *Code*), seeking revocation of certification order no. 9958-U issued on October 25, 2010, certifying the Office and Professional Employees International Union as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of Canadian Helicopters Limited comprising:

all aircraft maintenance engineers, apprentice engineers and avionics technicians employed by Canadian Helicopters Limited in the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Division, excluding supervisory base AMEs/AME Managers, Assistant Chief Engineer, HUMS Manager and those above.

**AND WHEREAS**, following investigation of the application, consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned and the holding of a representation vote, the Board is satisfied that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit no longer wish to be represented by the Office and Professional Employees International Union.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that, pursuant to the provisions of section 39 of the *Code*, certification order no. 9958-U dated October 25, 2010, be revoked, and it is hereby revoked.
