WHEREAS the Canada Industrial Relations Board (the Board) has received an application from the applicant, pursuant to section 38(1) of the *Canada Labour Code* (the *Code*), seeking revocation of certification order no. 11510-U issued on May 21, 2020, certifying the Seafarers' Entertainment and Allied Trades Union of Canada as bargaining agent for a unit of employees of C.T.M.A. Express Ltd. comprising:

all delivery drivers and delivery persons/material handlers of
C.T.M.A. Express Ltd., working in Îles de la Madeleine, **excluding**
casual employees.

AND WHEREAS, following investigation of the application and consideration of the submissions of the parties concerned, the Board is satisfied that a majority of the employees in

the bargaining unit no longer wish to be represented by the Seafarers' Entertainment and Allied Trades Union of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the certified bargaining agent is not opposed to this application.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Canada Industrial Relations Board that, pursuant to the provisions of section 39 of the *Code*, certification order no. 11510-U dated May 21, 2020, be revoked, and it is hereby revoked.
