## CERTIFICATION ORDER

**WHEREAS** the Union des écrivaines et écrivains québécois was certified under the *Status of the Artist Act* by the Canadian Artists and Producers Professional Relations Tribunal on February 2, 1996;

**AND WHEREAS** since April 1, 2013, the Canada Industrial Relations Board is responsible for the administration of Part II of the *Status of the Artist Act*;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Canada Industrial Relations Board hereby confirms that the

### **UNION DES ÉCRIVAINES ET DES ÉCRIVAINS QUÉBÉCOIS**

is certified to represent, for the purposes of professional relations with all producers subject to the *Status of the Artist Act* (S.C. 1992, c.33) throughout Canada, a sector composed of:

- a. authors of original French language literary or dramatic works intended for publication;  
and
- b. authors of French language literary or dramatic works originally intended for the stage, radio, television, cinema or audio-visual media at the time of publication of the work in any medium and for that purpose only.

**AND that**, for the purposes of section 28(2) of the *Status of the Artists Act*, the original date of the certification remains February 2, 1996.
