Re: Medisys Health Group Inc. ("Medisys"), Medisys Health Group Trust, Medisys Holding LP, Medisys GP Limited, 4267486 Canada Limited (collectively, the "Applicants") - Application to Cease to be a Reporting Issuer under the securities legislation of Alberta, Manitoba, Ontario and Québec (the "Jurisdictions")

The Applicants have applied to the local securities regulatory authority or regulator (the "Decision Maker") in each of the Jurisdictions for a decision under the securities legislation (the "Legislation") of the Jurisdictions to have ceased to be a reporting issuer in the Jurisdictions.

each of the Decision Makers is satisfied that the test contained in the Legislation that provides the Decision Maker with the jurisdiction to make the decision has been met and orders that the Applicants are deemed to have ceased to be reporting issuers.
