BRYANT HURST

WHEREAS:

- (A) On March 2, 2015, the Executive Director of the Alberta Securities Commission ("ASC") entered into a Settlement Agreement and Undertaking with Bryant Hurst;
- **(B)** On March 13, 2015, The Manitoba Securities Commission ("Commission") issued a Notice of Hearing ("Notice") giving notice of its intention to hold a hearing pursuant to section 148.4 of *The Securities Act*, R.S.M. 1988, c. S50 as amended ("Act") to consider whether or not it was in the public interest to grant orders with respect to Bryant Hurst;
- **(C)** Bryant Hurst, self-represented, has consented to the issuance of this order and has waived his right to a full hearing;
- **(D)** The Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this order.

IT IS ORDERED:

- **1. THAT**, pursuant to section 148 of the Act, Bryant Hurst cease trading in and purchasing securities or derivatives until and including March 2, 2018, except that:
 - he may trade in and/or purchase securities or derivatives, through a registrant who has been given a copy of this order, using one Registered Retirement Savings Plan account;
 - (b) he may purchase securities in an issuer whose securities are not distributed to the public; and
 - (c) he may trade in and/or purchase securities or derivatives, through a registrant who has been given a copy of this order, using one Registered Education Savings Plan account for each of his children.
