## OPINION

HENDLEY, Senior Judge.

- {\*333} **{1}** Pursuant to § 16-7-14 (C) (2), N.M.S.A. 1953 (Repl. Vol. 1970) the Court of Appeals is authorized to certify to the Supreme Court issues of substantial public interest that should be determined by the Supreme Court.
