### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

### VANZI, Judge.

11 Defendant has appealed following his convictions for DWI and failure to maintain lane. We previously issued a notice of proposed summary disposition proposing to affirm. Defendant has filed a memorandum in opposition. After due consideration, we remain unpersuaded.

- **{2}** Because the relevant background information has previously been set forth, and there is no dispute relative thereto, [MIO 1] we will avoid undue reiteration, and proceed directly to the content of the memorandum in opposition.
- **(3)** Defendant continues to assert that the district court erred in denying his motion to suppress. [MIO 1] However, Defendant offers no additional argument or authority in support of his position.
- 43 As we previously observed, [CN 2] the district court thoroughly and thoughtfully considered this issue, and duly concluded that Defendant was not prejudiced. [RP 107-13] Succinctly stated, we perceive no error.
- **{5}** Accordingly, we affirm.
