Summary: A father appealed from an order imposing conditions on his access to his teenaged sons that he not use marijuana eight hours before driving them in his vehicle and that he not drive outside of Halifax Regional Municipality with them.

Issues: Did the trial judge err in imposing the conditions on access?
Did the trial judge err in ordering that the father pay costs of \$800 to the mother who represented herself at trial?

Result: Appeal dismissed. No error by trial judge.
