Summary: The appellant was found guilty of professional misconduct by a discipline committee established pursuant to the **Land Surveyor's Act** and suspended from practice for three months. He appealed alleging that the decisions were unreasonable.

Result: Appeal dismissed. Decisions were reasonable in the circumstances.
