ISSUE: Fitness of the sentence

RESULT: Decision of sentencing judge not based on a misunderstanding of

R. v. Thompson, [1994] O.J. No. 2855 (Ont. Gen Div.) or that accused in a commercial or profit-driven enterprise. The judge emphasized appropriate aggravating and mitigating factors. Three

years held to be a fit sentence.
