**SUBJECT:** Condition of custody - not to remove children from specific geographic area in Nova Scotia

**SUMMARY:** The applicant requests a condition to custody that the mother not be allowed to removed the children from Y. to K. permanently. **Blois v. Blois** and **Gordon v. Goertz** considered.

**ISSUE:** Whether the mother should be prevented by Court Order from removing the children from S. to K. permanently.

**RESULT:** Condition ordered that neither party remove the children permanently from [...] County. The father had a major role to play in the children's lives.
