HEARD: March 21 and May 9, 2003

DECISION DATE: June 23, 2003

SUBJECT: Variation of child support under S. 37 of the Maintenance and Custody Act, for three children - two of whom are adult, university students.

SUMMARY: Variation granted; however, university expenses were not apportioned between the parties. Court examined, in detail, the means and conditions of the parties and the two adult children.

ISSUE(S): Should there be a retroactive variation of child support?

Should current and past university expenses be apportioned between the parties?

RESULT: Variation granted with respondent father ordered to pay 50% of outstanding university fees for one adult child, and ordered to pay 60% of university expenses beyond loans and bursaries for another adult child. No retroactive variation granted.
