Summary: Plaintiff subdivided lands including Cow Bay Lake; Registrar General of

Land Titles issued Stop Orders; plaintiff seeks to have orders rescinded or mandamus granted; defendants say action is *res judicata* because of Order-in-Council in 1919 pursuant to *Water Act*, S.N.S. 1919, c. 5.

Issue: Does *res judicata* apply?

Result: 1) Order-in-Council is one to which *res judicata* can apply;

2) Same question was not decided by Order-in-Council;

a) Order-in-Council dealt with Cow Bay River;

b) Alternatively, Order-in-Council did not <u>decide</u> Cow Bay Lake was a water course;

3) Order-in-Council was a decision in personam and not in rem;

4) Alternatively, in exercise of judicial discretion, application should be dismissed.
