

1. IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that leave to appeal be granted.



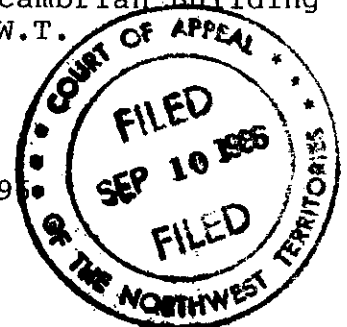
