MEMORANDUM OF JUDGMENT

[1] The Appellants appeal two chambers orders by the case management judge that dismissed their application to compel the Respondent, which is not a party to the

litigation, to produce videotapes, and which denied the Appellants-request for a rehearing

of the motion to produce.

In exercising his discretion pursuant to Rule 231, the case management judge [2]

considered and weighed several factors including the necessity for production, the

Respondents status and the sufficiency of the evidence adduced on the motions. In so

doing, he made no error in principle. Given the standard of appellate review from a

discretionary order by a case management judge, the Appellants have failed to

demonstrate a reviewable error with respect to either order.

[3] Accordingly, the appeals are dismissed.
