Costigan J.A. (for the Court):

[1] The Crown concedes that the sentence imposed by the sentencing judge was unfit given the sentencing requirements of the *Youth Criminal Justice Act*, S.C. 2002, c. 1. We agree.

[2] Therefore, we set aside the sentence imposed and substitute a sentence of time served on the custodial portion of the sentence to be followed by 2.5 months of supervision.
