**MEMORANDUM**

Counsel for the interim administrators of this estate requests directions.

Counsel should prepare a draft order providing as follows:

1. Confirming that the 1994 Will has been proven in solemn form and can be admitted to probate.
1. Outlining the proposed distribution of the assets of the estate. The distribution to local charities to be made in the discretion of the administrators can be listed simply under that general heading.

The draft order should be consented to by counsel on behalf of all of the designated beneficiaries of both the 1992 and the 1994 wills. If a party is not represented by counsel and signs a consent in his or her personal capacity, then an affidavit of execution must

be attached.

Once the order is entered then a separate application for probate, as required by Probate Rule 8, together with the supporting affidavits required by the rules, can be filed. The clerk will open a separate estate file. A copy of this consent order should be appended to the applicant's affidavit on the probate application.
