REASONS FOR JUDGMENT

In this criminal proceeding the accused is charged with sexually assaulting the complainant in 1986 at Nanisivik, Northwest Territories, contrary to s.246.1 c.c. He has elected trial by judge and jury. In June 1995 the Court set the date of his jury trial as October 23, 1995, at Nanisivik.

The accused has made application for a change of venue to Arctic Bay or, alternatively, for an order directing the Sheriff to include the residents of Arctic Bay in the "pool" used for selection of the jury panel.

For the reasons issued today in R. v. Esau Tatatoapik (CR 02904), the application is denied.
